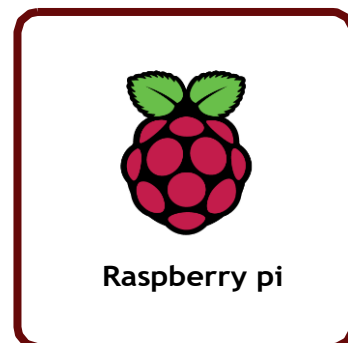

Eligible candidates are invited to apply for admission into **1st Year B.A., BBA, B. Com, and B.Sc.** degree courses offered at Telangana Tribal Welfare Residential Degree Colleges (TGTWRDCs) for **Men** and **Women** for the Ac Year 2026–27.

Eligibility Criteria:

Students who have passed/ appearing for second year intermediate or equivalent examination with 40% marks including vocational courses held in March/June 2026, 2025 are eligible to apply. Students whose parents' annual income is less than Rs. 1,50,000/- (in case of rural areas) Rs. 2,00,000/- (in case of urban areas) are eligible.

2. The Candidate should be ready with the following documents for filling up the application

- Copy of SSC (Grade 10) Marks Sheet
- Copy of Intermediate (Grade 12) Marks Sheet
- Latest Income Certificate (Issued after 01.01.2026)
- Community/Caste Certificate
- Passport-size Photos

3. Fee particulars: Rs.100/- for Application & DOST Registration Fees

4. Applications can be submitted at the respective colleges.

5. Based on the course studied at Intermediate or its equivalent, the candidate will be assigned the respective seat.

6. The candidates are advised to fill in the application with utmost care as they will be solely responsible for any mistakes/incorrect information entered in the application form.



General Information:

1. For women colleges only, women candidates should apply and for Men colleges only men candidates should apply.
2. For seeking admission to special colleges listed in Tribal Welfare Degree colleges, the candidates from all the districts of Telangana can apply.
3. The admissions into 1st Year Degree Course offered by Telangana Tribal Welfare Residential Degree Colleges
4. Applicants also fulfill other admission criteria stipulated by TGTWREI Societies, Hyderabad
5. Societies reserve the right to change the rules of admissions as per the directions of the universities, government and other regulatory bodies from time to time.
6. The Convener reserves the right to cancel the admission at any stage, if the particulars furnished by the candidate are found incorrect or against the rules of admission.
7. The number of courses offered, and the course combinations may vary depending on the number of applications received for that course

The Academic Success Meet celebrated students' achievements and inspired them to excel in academics, while also encouraging a culture of learning and dedication.



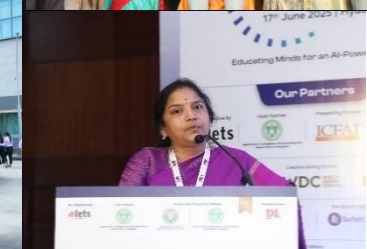
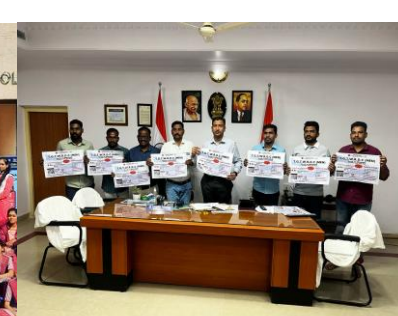
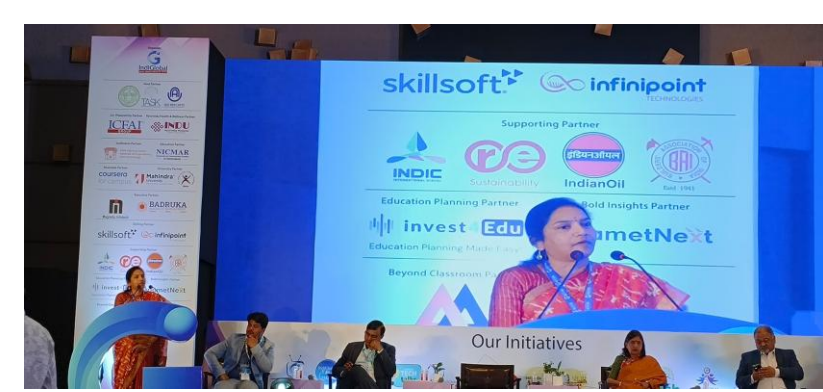
